## WORDLWIDE COVER OUTSIDE WORK HOURS

Most Equity members 'in benefit' currently receive personal accident cover while performing, rehearsing, practicing or training in connection with a professional performance in film, television, theatre, variety or similar media, including the commute to work.

From 1 September 2010, Equity members engaged on qualifying West End contracts can extend the cover to operate on a 24-hour-a-day worldwide basis meaning that accidents outside work would be insured. Qualifying contracts are: West End Theatre, the National Theatre, the Globe, the Donmar Warehouse, the Young Vic, Soho Theatre and Extra Chorus in the Opera Houses.

To register, simply complete and return the application form overleaf. You can pay by cheque payable to Equity for £5 or include your debit or credit card details on the form, alternatively, you can supply those details over the phone to Jennifer Simpson on 020 7670 0240 or Wayne Bebb on 020 7670 0234. You will be insured for 12 months on receipt of your payment provided you maintain your Equity membership. A confirmation of cover will be issued on receipt and a renewal reminder will be sent within the year.

## COVER BENEFITS

### Loss of life/permanent disability

from the members Equity related occupation **£20,000**

**Temporary total disablement** from the members Equity related occupation **£125 (per week)**  
Payable to a maximum 52 weeks excluding the first two weeks.

In the event of you leaving a West End contract, the cover will continue provided that you have evidence of a current or proposed professional performance contract, stage managers contract or professional performance teaching/choreographing contract. Please note without such evidence as described above, no benefit will be payable.

## POLICY SUMMARY

### Who is eligible for cover?

Any member of Equity aged less than 75 years who is resident within the UK currently engaged on a qualifying West End contract.

### Is cover worldwide?

Cover is worldwide (other than any country where the Foreign Office advises against travel) provided that you are usually resident in the United Kingdom.

### Duration of cover

The period of Insurance will be for 12 months provided that you remain an Equity member in benefit engaged in or have evidence of a proposed Equity Related Occupation (as defined in the policy).

### Key features

This policy will provide the benefits stated above following Bodily Injury caused by Accident as defined by the policy.

### What is not covered?

- The first 14 days of a claim for weekly benefits following Temporary Total Disablement.
- Aeronautics (flying, parachuting etc) unless in connection with a professional performance or as a passenger in air travel.
- Accident whilst under the influence of drugs.
- Suicide or self injury.
- Involvement in the armed forces.
- Fighting, duelling, mountaineering, cliff or rock climbing, riding and racing, unless in connection with a professional performance.
- Illness, disease, naturally occurring condition or degenerative process.
- Any gradually operating cause.
- Any pre existing physical weakness, defect, disease or injury sustained prior to this insurance.
- Psychological disorder.
- Accident arising from a non Equity occupation.

### Renewing your insurance

At least 21 days before each policy renewal date, you will be advised of the premium and terms and conditions that will apply for the following year. All premiums quoted are inclusive of Insurance Premium Tax.
